## Sunday Reflection

**'My thoughts are not your thoughts, my ways not your ways.'**

Today, in most Third World cities and towns there is a market area, not for selling commercial goods, but human labour.

Some skilled, but mainly unskilled, workers line up early each morning hoping that some contractor will come along and hire them even for a day. Normally when a contractor comes along, he will select the young and strong and pay them a pittance.

Those who are weak or aged are ignored. It is a most humiliating experience for these workers who often have families dependant on them and no social welfare benefits of any kind to fall back on. This degrading practice existed in Christ's time and he addresses some of the issues involved in today's gospel story. The parable makes the point that God's generosity is extended to everyone irrespective of their status, ability, or appearance in life.

We tend to put limits on God. However, he is not small minded or selective like ourselves.
