Mission Sunday

Pope Francis' message to celebrate World Mission Day 2023, explores the disciples' story on the road to Emmaus (Lk 24:13-35). Have you experienced a time in life when you felt perplexed, puzzled, or dismayed? Then, something happened to dispel those feelings and your heart lifted. That's how it was for the two disciples; confused and grief-stricken, as they walked from Jerusalem to Emmaus. Jesus approached them, spoke to them and they had a life-changing experience. This October, school, parish and family communities celebrate World Mission Sunday. The Church invites each community to reflect on Pope Francis' message, inspired by the disciples' story (Lk24:13-35). The Church celebrates World Mission Day, firstly, to offer God's people an opportunity to renew their commitment to proclaim the Gospel and secondly, to give pastoral activities a greater missionary perspective. Another goal is to seek finance to advance evangelisation in mission territories.
