Reflection: The Dead Sea

The Dead Sea is a lake that lies in a deep depression between Jordan and Israel. It is the lowest body of water in the world, lying about 1300 feet below sea level. The River Jordan flows into it, but water has no way of flowing out of it. That means that the only way surplus water is carried away is by evaporation, leaving behind salt and minerals to accumulate over time.

The Dead Sea is eight times saltier than other seas, meaning its water is much denser, so people can't sink or swim, only float. It is much too dangerous to drink its water. While the River Jordan brings fish into it, they immediately die. The Dead Sea has now become a symbol of all that has gone wrong in the Middle East, including death and destruction.
