Reflection: Truth George Orwell's famous novel Animal Farm is a fanciful description about how animals take over the world and immediately declare a charter of equality. Soon, however, it becomes obvious that some of the animals are more equal than others as various cliques emerge. All societies tend to have glass curtains because of prejudices, suspicions and differences. St Oscar Romero proposed that the only antidote to this was the Gospel Truth as enunciated by Jesus. "If there is not truth based in love, there is hypocrisy. Often fine words are said, handshakes given, perhaps even a kiss, but there is no truth. A civilisation where trust of one for another is lost, where there is so much lying and no truth has no foundation. In such an environment, when the truth is spoken, it gives offence. Our societies need a total conversion and change of heart in order that the truth of Jesus is welcomed"
