Sunday Reflection – Jesus said: 'I am the good shepherd'

A famous singer on tour was invited by an old man to sing the well-known psalm 'The Lord is my Shepherd'. He agreed on condition that the old man would sing it afterwards. Both sang it well. "The difference between us", the singer confessed afterwards, "is that I know the song but you know the Shepherd. I sang from my head but you sang from both head and heart". To truly know and love Jesus means that we reflect his presence in our words and actions like the old man. How this may come about is described by the poet Longfellow in the following lines:

*The heights which great men reach were not attained by sudden flight;
but they, while their neighbours slept, were toiling upward in the night*

Brokenness

Our brokenness is the wound through which the full power of God can penetrate our being and transfigure us in God. Loneliness is not something from which we must flee but the place from where we can cry out to God, where God, our Shepherd, will find us and we will find God. Yes, through our wounds the power of God can penetrate us and become like rivers of living water to irrigate the arid earth within us. Thus, we may irrigate the earth of others, so that hope and love are reborn.
