Sunday Reflection – Truth: In a village in India, five blind men lived together. One day they happened to come near an animal which someone told them was an elephant. ‘What is an elephant like?’ they asked. They were invited to feel its body. ‘Why and elephant is like a pillar,’ said the first. He had felt only its leg. ‘No, no, it’s like a barrel,’ said another, who had felt only the belly. A third said, ‘It is like a rope,’ for he had felt the tail. A fourth said, ‘It is like a hose,’ he had felt the trunk. ‘It is like a winnowing-fan,’ said the last man, who had felt only the ear. So, they began to argue among themselves. Each said that his description of the elephant was the true one.

All of us, like the blind men, find a part of the truth and think we have grasped it all. As a result, human arrogance is born in us. Christ spoke the fullness of truth in today’s Gospel and we get the arrogant human response – resistance.
