Sunday Reflection:

All life is sacred'. The Irish Bishops have requested that we dwell on the sacredness of all earthly forms of life this weekend, particularly human life. The following is a North American Indian's prayer to our God of life:

O Great Spirit, whose voice I hear in the winds, and whose breath gives life to the world, hear me.

I come to you as one of your many children, I am small and weak. I need your strength and wisdom.
