Sunday Reflection:

In any lifetime, Christian or not, there are innumerable little deaths – always painful and frightening that can't be avoided: the failure of an exam and change of course, perhaps: the break up of a love affair; the loss of a childish faith; seeing one's child leave home for the first time; moving house; the loss of a job; retirement etc. Cling to what you have lost at that moment and you're lost. Unclench your hands and let it slip away and you are ready to receive the unimagined new life. If we can learn that habit from all the small occasions for dying which may come to us, the when the last letting-go is called for, it will be familiar and confident. Our formation of that habit will be immeasurably strengthened as we keep our eyes on the truth about God and about life revealed in Jesus, whose attitude was: I lay down my life to receive it back again in order to live eternally in heaven.

As Albert Schweitzer puts it, "Once we contemplate the distant view right to the end, we appreciate life and love. When we are familiar with death, we accept each week, each day, as a gift."
