Advent is a time of waiting

Our waiting is different from that of the Old Testament people and our hope has a different quality.

They waited for a future: *We watch for God's presence now.*

They hoped for a future event: *We hope that what is hidden might become visible.*

They waited for the world to change: *We are called to work for a change that has already begun.*

They looked to a distant horizon: *We have to see what is happening under our noses.*

So, Advent is the celebration of the coming of God, in the past, in the future and in the present.

We are his point of entry. His coming in the past remains buried in the past unless he comes again in us.

His coming in the future will never happen – if he can find no entry to our hearts right now.

Letting go

Slowly, she celebrated the sacrament of letting go. First, she surrendered her green, then the orange, yellow and red.

Finally, she let go of the brown. Shedding her last leaf, she stood empty and silent, stripped bare.

Leaning against the winter sky, she began her vigil of trust.
