Sunday Reflection: Our landscape is part of God's creation and also part of our inheritance. Celtic Spirituality reminds us of our Christian origins, which are based on a great love and reverence for all aspects of our natural environment. Our patron saints, Patrick, Colmcille and Brigid appear to have shared this reverence for the things of nature. While aspects of their stories may be mythical, yet the 'Shamrock' of Patrick, the 'Crane Bird' of Colmcille, and the 'Rush Cross' of Brigid are emblems we all feel comfortable with. Yesterday, we honoured St Brigid, who always took special care of people, animals and God's earth. She is traditionally associated with blessings, a long practice in Irish spiritually of blessing people, places and objects. For example, 'as Gaeilge' our greeting for another person is 'Dia dhuit'. On departure we may also say 'Goodbye' which is a contraction for 'God be with you'. Brigid's best-known title is 'Muire na nGael' – Mary of the Gael.
