Reflection: 'He withdrew from them and was carried up to heaven.'

On Ascension Day Jesus withdrew his physical presence from his disciples. But physical absence does not mean absence of presence. People can be very close to one another even though separated by thousands of miles. In fact, physical presence can sometimes actually get in the way of intimate communication. Many of our disappointments in life are caused by the fact that seeing and touching do not always create the closeness we seek. For people to grow together there must be periods of absence as well as presence. In absence we see each other in a new way. We are less distracted by a person's idiosyncrasies and are better able to appreciate his or her true worth. 'Absence makes the heart grow fonder.' When we think of each other with love, a spiritual bond is created between us and we enter into a new intimacy. For those who love one another there is no such place as 'far away'.
