Reflection: 'First collect the dandel.....'

A farmer was invited to identify the weeds in one of his fields. He started by naming docks, ragwort, thistles, nettles and dandelions. Already he had made mistakes. Take for example the dandelion in all its uniqueness.

It deserves to be admired rather than condemned. Although white haired in full bloom, it has much potential. A puff of wind (the Spirit) can disperse the seeds. Each seed can be carried along to new place. New life comes from what seems dead. A dandelion is not pretentious. It looks delicate but it is full of iron. It prefers poor soil and will flourish outside the enclosed garden. It provides joy for little children. Although each seed is autonomous and goes its separate way, it reaches maturity alongside others. Its yellow flower has a beauty and fragrance all of its own. The dandelion, poorly appreciated, is a symbol for life and a healing herb. An astute farmer is patient and discerning in separating the wheat and the dandel.
