Sunday Reflection: 'He welcomes sinners and eats with them.'

The Gospel describes a shepherd's search, a woman's frantic sweeping, a father's irrational forgiving. All these 'lost and found' stories remind us that God's relationship with us is not about practicality but prodigality. Part of us can wonder what the older son was like – the brother of the Prodigal Son. Is he like the dutiful son or daughter who stayed at home in Ireland? Likeable, trustworthy – the one who got the place after their parents, but never saw the sights, never got married, or made the money. Had he that mixture of resentment and loyalty that we recognise in so many who stayed too long at a post wondering and hoping? Duty soured their soul; resentment scarred their life. Actions performed with arms and feet, but not from their heart. Too much loyalty to parents can stifle initiative. Yeats once wrote, 'Too long a sacrifice can make a stone of the heart'. It may be why T.S. Eliot described the greatest treason as doing the right thing for the wrong reason.
